

Jacksonville Through the Lens:
Jacksonville Historical Society Photo Contest
Official Rules 2017

The Jacksonville Historical Society Photo Contest, *Capturing Jacksonville*, is generously underwritten by a grant from William H. Jeter, Jr. and Deanne M. Clark.

Contest overview

All photographs submitted **must be taken** within Duval County between August 1, 2016 and the contest deadline on Tuesday, August 22, 2017. Photo submissions should **capture Jacksonville, Florida** life through a place, an event, the city's people, the city's history and architecture, the area's social or cultural life, or a combination of these categories, including photos of daily life.

Prizes Awarded

Each photograph will be judged individually. No entrant will be eligible for more than one prize award. The grand prize winner will receive \$1,000. The second place winner will receive \$500. The third place winner will receive \$300, and two honorable mention award winners will be presented \$100 each. Prize determinations are final unless an image is proven to belong to someone other than the entrant. The Jacksonville Historical Society employees and Board of Directors are not eligible to enter.

Photographer / Copyright:

The contest is open to all ages. Do not submit a photo taken by someone other than you. You must be the sole owner of the image submitted. Your submissions and entry forms are your guarantee that you are the author of the photo.

Number of Entries:

An individual may submit up to four (4) photos.

Requirements and how to enter:

An **Entry Agreement**/Application is downloadable [here](#) and must accompany submissions. JHS requires the images to be submitted in digital format. The digital images must be accompanied by a completed **Photo Description Form** found [here](#). If you are submitting multiple images (limit 4), be sure to indicate clearly which description belongs with each photo. **JPEG images of photos must be in a resolution between DPI 300 and DPI 600 and/or 1800 x 2400 pixels.**

Deadline

Photo entries must be received by 3 p.m. August 22, 2017 or postmarked by August 22. (See below for delivery methods.)

Hand-deliver or mail your entry

The digital images may be hand-delivered with the entry form to the Jacksonville Historical Society, 314 Palmetto Street, Jacksonville 32202, **between 11a.m. and 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday only beginning through the contest deadline of Tuesday, August 22.**

Alternatively, the hard copies and the digitized images and entry form may be placed in U.S. mail addressed to the Jacksonville Historical Society, 314 Palmetto Street, Jacksonville 32202, and **postmarked no later than August 22, 2017.**

Photo Restrictions:

Images must be appropriate for display.

Required Release Form:

Photos containing recognizable people **must be accompanied by a signed released form**, found [here](#).

Ownership/Use Rights:

No watermarks, signatures, or copyright notices may be added to the images. Submission of your photograph(s) grants the Jacksonville Historical Society (JHS) the right **to publish and display** the photographs. Submitted photographs will become part of the **photographic archives** of the JHS. **The winning** photographs may **be reproduced for sale** by the JHS for fundraising purposes. **By request at the time of entry, photographers may retain the copyright on their images, subject to allowance for usage by the JHS as described above.**

Your submitted photos and digital images will not be returned.
